## **East West Link (Eastern Section) Project Assessment Committee**

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On 21 October 2013, the Minister for Planning appointed an Assessment Committee (the Committee) under sections 35 and 235 of the *Major Transport Projects Facilitation Act 2009* to consider matters associated with the proposed East West Link Comprehensive Impact Statement. The Committee comprises Ms Kathy Mitchell (Chair), Mr Nick Wimbush (Deputy Chair), Mr William O'Neil, Dr Lyn Denison, Mr Des Grogan, and Mr Jim Holdsworth.

As per Part 8 and 9 of its Terms of Reference, the Committee has retained the services of Mr Chris Wren SC as legal counsel, and Dr Sandy Bennet and Mr Doug Munro to provide specialist written and verbal advice.

The Committee advises that its members, its technical advisers and specialist assistants have all declared no conflicts of interest in this matter.

Please note that all hearings are being audio recorded, and all material provided to the Committee will be treated as public documents.

All submitters need to be familiar with the Committee's Terms of Reference and particularly Parts 1(3)(a)-(c); 2(2)(a)-(e); and 2(7)(a)-(i) as it relates to matters that the Committee can consider.

A Preliminary Hearing was held on Tuesday 14 January 2014 at the Mercure Melbourne Treasury Gardens and a copy of the Committee's Directions, Hearing Timetable and Distribution List are attached. The following key dates are relevant to this matter:

# Assessment Committee Directions

## East West Link (Eastern Section) Project Assessment Committee

### The Public Hearings and Timetable

1. The Public Hearings will be held from Monday 3 March to Tuesday 15 April 2014 at the Mercure Melbourne Treasury Gardens at 13 Spring Street Melbourne, in accordance with the attached timetable. Each hearing day will commence at 10.00am.
2. On Day 1, Linking Melbourne Authority (LMA); the Minister for Planning (through the Department of Transport, Planning, and Local Infrastructure); Melbourne, Yarra, Moonee Valley and Moreland City Councils; EPA; and a combined 'Community Group' are directed to provide a short overview of their submissions, the key issues each will be exploring and the way in which it will be presenting its case.
3. The combined 'Community Group' submission is to be coordinated by the Protectors of Public Land Victoria and Royal Park Protection Group. If you are a member of **any** of the community groups who made a submission, and you wish to be involved in this joint presentation, please contact Ms Moysey who will pass your details on to the appropriate person.
4. The same parties listed on Day 1 are invited to make brief closing submissions on the final day (Day 30).
5. The LMA will be provided with a right of reply on the final day.
6. As discussed in detail at the Preliminary Hearing, in order to be fair and reasonable to all parties and to provide the opportunity for as many submitters as possible to speak to submissions, the Committee has imposed strict but consistent timelines on all submitters. Time allocations have been set as follows:
  - a. Linking Melbourne Authority – 7 days plus 5 hours for closing;
  - b. Minister for Planning – 30 minute opening and 30 minute closing;
  - c. Local Councils – 10 days in total (time allocations for each to be confirmed);
  - d. EPA – 2 days;
  - e. Professional, Business and Community groups or sporting organisations - maximum of 45 minute each and an opportunity to present a combined 30 minute opening submission (as outlined in Directions 2 and 3 above);
  - f. Individual submitters between 5 and 10 minutes (please note that this has been reduced from 5- 20 minutes due to timetabling issues to accommodate all submitters who requested to be heard); and
  - g. Individual submitters who lodged a proforma submission and requested to be heard will be invited to attend an allocated session for group proforma submissions. (Those submitters will then not be allocated further time slots.)
7. The timetable and the allocation of days (as attached) is confirmed for Part 1 (Days 1 to 20), and Day 30 of the hearing process. Each party listed in the timetable for Days 1 to 20, (except for the Members of Parliament and Darebin City Council) must confirm with Ms Cutting the order in which each will be presenting its case, including confirmation of expert witnesses and the order of presentation of evidence. This information is to be provided by Tuesday 4 February 2014.
8. Part 2 of the timetable (Professional, Business and Community Organisations and Individual submitters) will be finalised and provided by 7 February 2014.

### Written Submissions at the Hearing

10. All parties are to bring to the Hearing at least fifteen (15) copies of any **additional** written submissions and accompanying documents (i.e. photographs, plans). Copies of original submissions are not required.
11. Submissions and material presented at the Hearing including PowerPoint presentations are public documents. All material will be given a document number, filed and be placed on a public table for review by any party. No material is to be taken from that file, as it is provided for the benefit of all submitters and parties.
12. It assists the Committee if written material presented at the Hearing is two-hole punched and stapled (not bound). Electronic copies of all submissions should be emailed in MS Word to the Committee post Hearing to [emma.moysey@dtpli.vic.gov.au](mailto:emma.moysey@dtpli.vic.gov.au).

### Exchange and presentation of Expert Witness Reports

13. Expert Witnesses Reports must comply with the Planning Panels Victoria *Guide to Expert Evidence* (<http://www.dpcd.vic.gov.au/planning/panelsandcommittees/guides-and-faqs>). Additionally, all expert evidence is to include a copy of the instructions for preparing the evidence, and a declaration of any pecuniary interest relevant to the proposed East West Link project.
14. Expert Witness Reports are to be circulated by **12.00pm on Thursday 20 February 2014**. Both **Hard and** Electronic copies must be provided in accordance with the attached Distribution List.
15. PPV will post a copy of any report received on its website. It would be helpful if electronic documents are in PDF format to assist with web publication. Due to restrictions imposed by the DTPLI website, the maximum file size for attachments is 2 MB. If your document is larger than this, then it should be split into logical sections, each less than 2 MB.
16. Expert Witness Reports must be available for viewing at each Council.
17. Expert Witness Reports should not refer to any individual submitter by name. If necessary, submitters should be referred to by submission number.
18. The Committee will indicate at the commencement of the Hearing which witnesses will be required to present its evidence.
19. Witnesses called to present their evidence are to provide a short summary statement, taking no longer than 15-20 minutes. This can be in the form of a PowerPoint presentation or a summary statement. These can be provided on the day of the giving of evidence and 30 copies must be made available.
20. With regard to cross examination:
  - a. Mr Wren SC will prepare and coordinate cross examination of key witnesses on behalf of the Committee, and he will go first.
  - b. The Committee will allow the Councils, the EPA and the LMA to cross examine the experts. All parties must be mindful of time constraints and questioning must be focussed and to the point.
  - c. Apart from cross examination by these parties, all requests to cross examine or ask questions of witnesses will need to be made in writing, and where appropriate, Mr Wren SC will review and ask the questions on behalf of the submitter. These questions are to be provided in writing to Mr Wren SC two working days prior to the scheduled hearing of the evidence by email to Ms Moysey.

### **Conclave of Expert Witnesses**

21. The Committee directs that following the submission of expert evidence, if there is more than one expert report in the following areas, those experts must meet to prepare statements of agreed facts and issues that remain in dispute. The statement must be signed by all participants. The meetings are to occur in the week of 24 February 2014. These meetings are to be coordinated and led by the LMA, and there is to be no client or legal representation present. The LMA is to coordinate any report of such meetings, and all reports are to be tabled on Day 1 of the Hearing. Experts in the following areas (if being called) must meet:
  - Traffic/transport/road design
  - Acoustics
  - Vibration
  - Groundwater
  - Land contamination
  - Air quality
  - Heritage
  - Flora and fauna
  - Social impacts
22. The expert meetings should canvass at least the following issues:
  - Understanding of methodology and assumptions in the assessments undertaken to date
  - Appropriateness of methodology for the task
  - The results obtained
  - Interpretation of results

### **Linking Melbourne Authority**

23. Provide a response to the Committee's section 57(4) paper (dated 13 January 2014). Fifteen hard copies of this response are to be provided to the Committee at Planning Panels Victoria by 5.00pm on Tuesday 11 February 2014. LMA's response will be made available on Planning Panels Victoria webpage. Please note that on page 5, question 6 of the section 57(4) request, the reference to *Part 3, Division 7, Subdivision 8 of the Act* should read *Part 3, Division 5, Subdivision 8 of the Act*.
24. Provide a written response to the matters raised about the adequacy of the Comprehensive Impact Statement and its consistency with the Scoping Directions by Messrs Ingram, Herington and Ley by Tuesday 11 February 2014.
25. Include in the response to Questions 1 to 6 of Document 1 (the section 57(4) paper), a response to matters raised by Yarra City Council including whether the LMA intends to revise the CIS, and the implications of this by Tuesday 11 February 2014.
26. At the Hearing, LMA to provide:
  - a. A map showing the location of submitters by submission number. This map should not refer to any submitter by name; and
  - b. Appropriate aerials and plans at large scale.

### **Minister for Planning**

27. Through the Department of Transport, Planning and Local Infrastructure, provide a written response clarifying the role of the Minister for Planning in these proceedings. Further, respond to Questions 1 to 6 of Document 1 (the section 57(4) paper). These responses are to be provided by Tuesday 11 February 2014.

### **Performance Requirements and Suggested Conditions**

28. Submitters who documented revised Performance Requirements and/or suggested Conditions in their written submission to the Committee, and who wish to meet with the LMA in accordance with Question 87 of the Section 57(4) paper, must advise Ms Moysey by 29 January 2014.
29. The LMA is directed to contact and meet with those submitters to discuss and prepare any revised version of the Performance Requirements and/or suggested conditions.

### **Site Inspections**

30. The Committee advised that it had undertaken a detailed inspection of the Project Area on 18 December 2013. It anticipates that it will undertake further inspections prior to and after the Public Hearings. If there are sites or areas that you wish the Committee to inspect, please advise Ms Moysey in writing by email by Tuesday 11 February 2014.

### **Hearing Protocols**

31. During the course of these proceedings, parties are welcome to enter and leave the Hearing room at any time.
32. All mobile phones are to be switched off in the Hearing room.
33. No party or individual, including the media is to approach the Committee at any time.
34. The Committee is not required to answer letters from any party or individual. All correspondence will be publicly disclosed by the Committee at the beginning of each day.
35. All present at the hearings must respect all parties at all times and calling out or interjecting will not be tolerated. Defamatory, insulting or abusive language is not permitted at any time. If such occurs, those responsible may be asked to leave the room.
36. Banners or placards and the like are strictly prohibited from being brought into the Hearing venue, including the foyer of these premises, at all times.
